

# **WEEKEND PENNANTS 2019 - CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

**STARTING TIME FOR PLAY:** varies by club – see end of document

## **CATERING ARRANGEMENTS**

- No “formal” morning tea. Tea, coffee etc. to be available at all clubs.
- At the following clubs, players may **NOT** bring own lunch, but can purchase lunch:  
**at Belrose, Neutral Bay and North Sydney**
- “Picnic Lunch” permitted at all other clubs
- Possible to also buy lunch at Mosman.

## **CONDITIONS OF PLAY** (See *WBNSW Weekend Pennant Conditions of Play*)

Self-selected team of four from the same club.

Minimum 10 Grading Points per team, from 2018 Pennant season.

Grade 1 players are not permitted to play Skip.

Players and positions may be changed each match, subject to the 10-point grading.

A player may not switch teams once the competition begins.

18 ends, 2-bowls per player.

1 Trial End before each game.

No “dead ends” – jack to be re-spotted at the T.

Registered club uniform to be worn.

There is NO player movement restriction in this event

## **INCLEMENT WEATHER (Rain, Heat, etc)**

The Controlling Body at each venue club must have access to, and understand their responsibilities under, the *WBNSW Recommendations for Play in Extreme Weather* (downloadable from WBNSW website). **If the venue club has its own, stricter policy for hot weather, the club’s policy will prevail.**

In inclement weather, Team Manager should contact the Team Manager of the host club for information no later than 1 hour before the scheduled start time; the Start of Play may be delayed up to 1.5 hours before the match is called off. Any match not commenced on the scheduled day must be played by mutual agreement prior to 14 September.

(Suggested dates are the weekends of: 27-28 July, 17-18 August and/or 7-8 September, if none of the participating players are involved in State fixtures on those dates.)

During a match, any appeal to the umpire regarding weather conditions must be made by the SKIP on behalf of the team.

## **DUTIES OF PENNANT TEAM MANAGERS**

- **Weekend Pennant Result Sheet** to be supplied by the HOME side.  
(Side on whose green the match is played, and/or named first on the draw.)
- **BA Registration No’s** only required to be listed on Pennant Result Sheet the FIRST TIME A PERSON PLAYS IN THE GRADE, and for the Regional Play-Off entry.
- Managers **toss a coin** to determine who plays first; winner of the toss has the choice to play first or oblige their opponent to play first.

- **Scoreboard** and **Weekend Pennant Result Sheet** to show the HOME SIDE on the LEFT and the VISITING SIDE on the RIGHT.
- When the match is completed, each Manager to ensure that:
  - scorecards are correctly filled in; correct score in the appropriate place
  - **seconds** have signed the cards and recorded the time completed
  - all information is correctly recorded on Weekend Pennant Result Sheet, and
  - both Side Managers have signed the Weekend Pennant Result Sheet.
- The WINNING TEAM MANAGER to **EMAIL** the results by **10.00 am** on the Monday following the game, to District Match at: billie.maas@bigpond.com
- In a **drawn game**, the HOME side should report the results.
- The HOME Team retains **the scorecards**, to be kept at their Club
- If a **mistake** is detected on the Pennant Result Sheet it shall be altered to agree with the Scorecards; the cards duly signed will be taken as the correct score.

### **DETERMINATION OF A WINNER**

- (i) The team with the greatest number of points shall be the Section winner.
- (ii) If points are equal, the team with the greatest margin of net shots shall be the winner. (Total shots for, minus total shots against, equals net shots).
- (iii) If the net shots are also equal, the winner will be team with the greatest number of ends won.

Section winners play to determine the winner, with the highest-scoring side in the Post-Sectional Play-Off (PSPO) winning the Weekend Pennant. (If there are only two Sections competing, in the event of a drawn PSPO the Skips will toss again and extra end(s) will be played until a winner is found.
