CONDITIONS OF PLAY:

- 3 bowl pairs. 2 games of 11 ends each day.
 - **Start time: 9.00am on the green.** (No “morning tea”) **1st game must finish by 10.40am**
 - 2nd game to commence by 10.45am and **MUST be completed by 12.15pm.**
 - Played at: Seaforth & Belrose (see the Draw for your team’s venue each week).
 - Green fees to be paid at venue club each week:
Seaforth \$12 / Belrose \$12
 - SCORECARDS:
 - Players to bring own cards. (Spare cards will be available from those listed below.)
 - Cards from all games **to be handed in before you leave the venue**, to these players:

 - Conducted under the Laws of Bowls Crystal Mark 3rd edition, with these conditions:
 - **1 trial end** before the **first game only.**
 - No dead ends - Jack to be re-spotted on the 2-metre mark.
 - No player to “visit the head” before all her bowls are played. (Once at the mat end, skip may not reapproach the head.)
 - No umpire on duty. Please play in a spirit of goodwill. If you can’t agree on shot(s) ask for help from your Skips. Everyone who owns a longer-length measure (e.g. box string measure) please bring it and be prepared to share!
 - Each pairs team to include no more than one “Major” player.
 - The following players are considered “Major” (for this competition only):
 - Anyone who has won a Club or District Major Singles, Open or Senior Pairs championship *
 - Anyone who played Grades 1 or 2 Pennant in the last two seasons (2018 or 2019) *
- * NOTE: This competition is intended to provide less-experienced bowlers with an opportunity to compete against a variety of opponents, in partnership with a more experienced player. An experienced player who does not meet the “major” criteria above, but who would like to mentor a “minor” player, is free to reclassify herself as “major” for this event.
- Either player can Skip. Playing positions can be changed before the start of a new game.
 - **SUBSTITUTES: One** player/team may be **replaced** before Game 1 without penalty. A Substitute can take the place of any player on ONE of the three “sectional” days, but NOT BOTH on the same day (i.e., one of the entered players must be in the team each week). **Only a “minor” can replace a “minor”.**
 - ONE substitute per team may also be included in the Finals for any entrant not available on 19 Oct.
 - Any BA-logo clothing permitted (or ‘smart casual’ as per WBNSW dress code). Players in each team do not have to be dressed the same.
 - SCORING: The points ladder will be arranged by WINS + MARGIN.
 - The top-placed teams from Sectional play will compete in the Finals on Saturday 19 Oct. (If there is a tie for positions after the 6 games, tie-breakers will be Greatest Aggregate of Ends Won, then Shots.)
