President's Report 2019

It has been a very busy twelve months for North Shore District, especially for our hard-working Match Committee, as Women's Bowls New South Wales has introduced many new events to add to our already busy calendar. There has been high participation in all our District events, and it was especially encouraging to have many new bowlers not only play in these events but also perform very well. A very big thank you to all members of the Match Committee, they have done a fantastic job - Chairperson Sue Hamilton, Match Secretary Billie Maas, and Julie Baker, Brenda Walker and Fiona Vatiliosis. A special thank you to both Billie and Sue who are also Regional Umpire Educators and are responsible for our very well-trained umpires and markers, and again to Billie who keeps our website and Facebook pages up to date with events and news. Our website is the envy of many Districts!

The Selection Committee led by Pat Pierson has been out and about watching potential players for the Jean McKinnon and Anita Linden events. After consultation with Manly Warringah, the Jean McKinnon will now be a graded event, giving a broader range of players the opportunity to participate.

Vice Presidents Di Tracy and Bev Piper have been a wonderful support to me, both stepping in to represent me on many occasions. Bev also assisted in setting up our new Expenditure Policy and preparing a budget to comply with the requirements of WBNSW, and Di helped arrange our very successful WBNSW coaching clinics and is also assisting with the upcoming Karen Murphy coaching clinics.

Annette Renshaw has once again kept our finances in order throughout the year and has managed to fulfil the new requirements of WBNSW reporting with the minimum of fuss.

Rosemary Dale kindly took on the role of Chairman of Social this year. It became apparent that this position was not relevant any more, and we have changed our by-laws to reflect this. Rosemary has been a very welcome addition to our Committee.

Our District Secretary Angela Little keeps us all in order and well informed. There is good reason that no District or Club can operate without a Secretary! The new position of Match Secretary has hopefully lessened her load a little.

We should all be proud of the achievements of many of our North Shore District players over the past year. Neutral Bay won the Regional Grade 1 Pennant and will now play in the State play-off in August. Our North Shore District Championship winners performed extremely well in the Regional Play-offs. Belrose won the Open Pairs, Triples and Open Fours, St Ives the Senior Pairs, and Turramurra the Mixed Pairs. We wish all these players good bowling and the very best of luck when they go to the State Championships in September.

Ngoc Hau and Louise Amos of Killara reached the semi-finals of the State Champion of Champion Pairs, Jenny Hepburn was part of the winning NSW team at the Australian Senior Sides Championships, Midori Matsuoka won silver in the singles and bronze in the pairs at the 13th Asia Lawn Bowls Championships, Karen Price won the Regional Rookies and was a finalist for the WBNSW new player of the Year, Sue Hamilton was a finalist for the Club Official of the year, and Jenny Palmer has been selected in the over 60's City Side for the WBNSW City V Country event. Our teams in the Jean McKinnon played extremely well to draw away for a comfortable win in this event last year. The Anita Linden was disappointing as North Shore held a comfortable lead at

lunchtime but couldn't hold on in the afternoon when freezing conditions seemed to take their toll. Congratulations to all players selected to represent the District in these events, and best of luck to those who will be playing in the 2019 teams over the next two months.

The new events introduced by WBNSW have been met with mixed enthusiasm. The Regional Challenge was cancelled due to lack of interest, the Summer League did not go ahead in many Districts, including ours, due to lack of entries, and the new weekend pennant has entries by only four clubs (8 teams) in our District. It will be interesting to see if all these events are played again next year.

Thank you to Judy LeGras who ran the Harborside Triples which always proves to be a popular event. The winners this year were the Neutral Bay team of Taylor de Greenlaw, Kate Wingrove and Jess de Greenlaw, and they will play in the State play-off in November. Eleven-year-old Taylor has been really enjoying her bowls and played in her first District final in the Fours, and also competed in the State Junior Championships. I'm sure we will see a great deal more of her in the future.

I did not attend the District President's Conference as it clashed with our Regional play-offs, however I have kindly been updated on what was discussed by the President of Manly Warringah. I think a great deal of the content was similar to the past two conferences I attended; however I will follow up with WBNSW on a couple of other issues raised which need clarification.

I would like to thank all the volunteers and clubs who make our District work so efficiently. We greatly appreciate the clubs who host our District events and their members who are on hand to assist. A special thankyou to Belrose for providing the venue for our District Meetings, and also to Forestville who allowed us to meet there while Belrose was unavailable. Forestville also hosted the three days of our Regional Play-offs at very short notice and did a superb job.

Vice Presidents Bev Piper and Di Tracy, Rosemary Dale and Marilyn Brenner from Social , and Nerida King from Selection have decided not to stand again this year. We thank them most sincerely for their contribution to the North Shore District. We are grateful to those who have agreed to join the Committee, and I'm sure they will bring some fresh ideas and enthusiasm as we go forward.
