FORMAT: **Knock-out - 21 Ends - 2 bowls - Two rounds per day**
Two Trial Ends before each game

CATERING ARRANGEMENTS

No "picnic lunch" – sandwiches can be ordered on arrival, or purchase lunch in restaurant.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Played under *Laws of the Sport of Bowls Crystal Mark 3rd E^d version 3.2, BNSW 2022-23 Conditions of Play – General & BNSW 2022-23 Conditions of Play – State Championships.*

Players must remain affiliated with BNSW through the club from which entry was received.

SCORECARDS

District will supply scorecards for all rounds. Skips must complete the cards.

RESTRICTION ON MOVEMENT -- see *BNSW 2022-23 Conditions of Play - General - 33.1.4*

- **Leads & Seconds** may go to the “head” **only after delivering their 2nd bowls**.
- **Thirds** may move to Head end at start of any end. If **BOTH** are at the Head, they must go to mat together after the Seconds have played. If **ONLY ONE** is at the Head, they must go to mat end immediately it's their turn to play. No return to Head until **after their 2nd bowl**.
- **BOTH Skips** must go to the mat together when the Thirds have played all their bowls.
- **Skips** cannot return to the “head” until after they have played their 1st bowl
- Skips may follow their 1st bowl to the head, but must then stay at the head until it's their turn to play again. If they did not follow their 1st bowl, Skips can visit the head before playing their 2nd bowl.

REPLACING A PLAYER -- see *BNSW 2022-23 Conditions of Play -- General*

All the following apply **only with the approval of the Controlling Body**:

- Players entered in the team may be changed before their first round, provided one of the original members remains. (CoP 34.2) **All team alterations to be advised to District Match.**
- **One Substitute** may be used in each Round. (CoP 34.4). A Sub cannot play Skip.
- **One Replacement Player** may be used after the first round for any player incapable of continuing in the championship (CoP 34.5).
- Once constituted in a team, a defeated player is not eligible to be a Sub or Replacement in any other team in either the State, Senior or Open Reserve Fours. (CoP 34.3.2)

INCLEMENT WEATHER (Rain, Heat, etc)

- The Controlling Body must have access to, and understand their responsibilities under, the *BNSW Extreme Weather Guidelines* (downloadable from BNSW website). **If the venue club has its own, stricter policy for hot weather, the club's policy will prevail.**
- If a match is abandoned for the day by the Controlling Body the scorecards must be immediately handed to the Controlling Body, who will advise players when the match is to be completed. One substitute may be included in the team for the resumed match.
