Players 11 – 18 should arrive no later than 11.45am on Sunday 16th.

Morning competitors are allowed 30 minutes break between games.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- **First to 25-shots - Two trial ends permitted before each game.**
- **Knock-out**
- **ALL losers of morning games MUST mark in the afternoon** (unless directed otherwise).
- **Two rounds scheduled per day**
- Played under *Laws of the Sport of Bowls Crystal Mark v3.2 & BNSW Conditions of Play for Association Events and State Championships 1 July 2022 -- 30 June 2023.*
- To be eligible, entrants must remain members of club from which entry was received.

District winner to contest

Region 15 Play-Off, Sun 16 April (at Belrose)

* Note: Final round of District play is scheduled for the morning of Sun 16 April, followed by the Regional Play-Off in afternoon. Manly-Warringah Final will have been held during the week prior. North Shore Finalists may seek District Match approval to play on an earlier date (Sun 2 April or midweek.

PLAYER MOVEMENT RESTRICTIONS

Players will not be permitted to visit the head until after their third bowl.

SCORECARDS

District will supply the cards. Only one scorecard will be kept during match, by the marker.

CATERING ARRANGEMENTS

No “picnic lunch” – those playing both morning AND afternoon can purchase sandwich/roll between games for quick turnaround. Restaurant will be open for other orders.

LIVESTREAM

The Final may be “livestreamed” on the District’s **Facebook** page (northshorewomensbowls).

INCLEMENT WEATHER (Rain, Heat, etc)

The Controlling Body at each venue club must have access to, and understand their responsibilities under, the WBNSW *Recommendations for Play in Extreme Weather* (downloadable from WBNSW website).

If the venue club has its own, stricter policy for hot weather, the club’s policy will prevail.

If a match is abandoned for the day by the Controlling Body the scorecards must be immediately handed to the Controlling Body, who will advise players when the match is to be completed.

(If a marker is not available for the resumed game, Controlling Body must be notified so District Match can arrange a replacement marker.)

MATCH OFFICIALS

Venue Club to provide accredited Umpire for all rounds.

Venue Club to provide Markers for all morning games.

On 19 March, all losers of morning matches will be required mark in the afternoon.

On 26 March, markers for the afternoon games will be drawn by lot from amongst the losers of morning games.

District will arrange Marker for the Final.
